At the Y Remote Learning Camp, students in Kindergarten through eighth grade will be supported in completing their remote learning while also staying active and enjoying fun activities throughout the day. Remote learning pods begin at 8:00 am and end at 3:00 pm, with before and after care available beginning at 7:00 am and until 5:00 pm if needed at no additional cost for children pre-enrolled in our YMCA Child Care Program.

Y staff will assist students in logging on and connecting to their school programs using their own laptop device, will assist with questions during remote learning, and help to keep students on track as they connect with their teachers online. During class breaks and after schoolwork is completed, the Y team will get students up and moving in fun and creative ways to keep them engaged and active. We look forward to serving you and your children!

The history of our organization has been one of adapting to community needs and being there for our neighbors when they need us most. The last several months have been no exception.

The YMCA is uniquely equipped for childcare this fall because we have learned over the last few months how to keep children safe in these unprecedented times. When school closed in the spring, we began providing childcare to essential workers in a safe, caring and responsible way. Through this program, we were able to help students continue their remote learning while providing parents the opportunity to return to work. Since then, we have served hundreds of children in childcare and summer camp, taking every precaution to ensure the health and safety of the children, their families, our staff and the community at large.

On a national level, the YMCA served 40,000 children in essential childcare with 0 COVID-19 outbreaks. Our national and local safety protocols helped minimize exposure and maximize cleanliness. Throughout the pandemic, we have maintained safety procedures, and will continue to do so for after-school childcare and our School Days Out program this fall.

Since March, we have had hundreds of children in our care. As we prepare for the school year, we will keep these practices in place and continue to adapt to the changing environment.



Contactless Check-in and Health Screens

Check-in and check-out are conducted in a car line style. Children have temperatures taken and parents answer health screening questions.



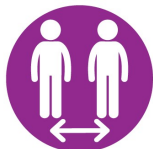
Enhanced Cleaning

We have heightened our cleaning efforts throughout the day and deep-cleaning after-hours.



Disinfecting Foggers

We added environmentally- friendly disinfecting foggers in all facilities to kill germs in hard-to-reach places.



Cohort Distancing

Children stay in their groups, with the same counselor, all day. Groups do not interact with each other. Ratios are limited to minimize contact.



Stay Home Policy

We require all students and staff to stay home if they are not feeling well.
